Pony Club WA Gear Check Manual – Amendments

Please note the following corrections/changes to the 2020 Gear Check Manual:

Dress requirements for each phase of Tetrathlon

There have been some minor changes to the dress requirements for Tetrathlon in 2020 Rules. The 2020 requirements are summarised below. The Tetrathlon committee apologises for not getting these changes updated in the 2020 Gear Checking Manual. In the case of any discrepancies the 2020 Tetrathlon Rules take precedence. The only exception is for medical armbands, these are compulsory for both Cross Country and Hickstead ridden phases as specified in the Gear Checking Manual.

Running: Singlets are permitted, competitors must not be stripped to the waist. Watches and timing devices are permitted. Competitors need to present with their bib number to have arm numbers applied but do not have to run in their bib.

Swimming: Swimming goggles and caps are recommended but not compulsory. Wet suits and swimming aids i.e. flippers, paddles are not permitted. Bathers should be of fabric and design that meets Australian Swimming rules, they may be one or two piece. Competitors need to present with their bib number to have arm numbers applied.

Shooting: Shirt must be long or short sleeved in club colours, no singlets. Shoes must be enclosed but not cover the anklebone. Silent timing devices are permitted. The use of special devices, taping or garments to support the competitors' arms, legs or body are prohibited. Caps/visors and glasses with corrective lenses or filters may be worn. Competitors need to present with their bib number but do not have to wear it while shooting.

Riding: Long sleeved shirts, back protectors, bib numbers, bridle/saddle numbers and medical armbands are all compulsory for both Hickstead and Cross Country ridden phases. If the ridden phase is show jumping only then gear checking rules for show jumping apply. No watches are allowed in any format of the ridden phase.



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
