

A BIDEN PRESIDENCY WOULD THREATEN AMERICA'S FREEDOM

From the people he's surrounding himself with to the radical policy agenda he plans to pursue, there's no question that a potential Biden Administration would be dangerous for the country

Over the past 18 months, House Democrats as they have systematically tried to take freedom and power away from the American people and give it to the federal government. Their disastrous proposals have fortunately not been implemented thanks to the leadership from the White House and Senate Republicans, but they are threatening to take this alarming vision and enact it if Joe Biden is elected President.

In recent days, the American people have learned more about just how disastrous a potential Biden Administration would be for the country. He teamed up with Bernie Sanders and his socialist allies, surrendering to their ideas in pushing out a radical framework that would guide the domestic policy agenda for his presidency, earning praise from the Vermont Senator.

The below rundown details the flawed nature of what Joe Biden is proposing and highlights how they people working with him on this agenda have either extreme views that would abandon America's founding principles, or have a track record of failure that would advance ideas that are not in our nation's best interest.

Domestic Policy Framework

Knowing that the far-left controls today's Democrat Party, [Joe Biden teamed up with Bernie Sanders and his socialist colleagues](#) to produce a framework for policies that his potential Administration would pursue if they are elected. [The resulting product](#) would make Biden the "most progressive President since FDR," [according to Senator Sanders himself](#), and removes any doubt that a Biden presidency would be steered by the same radicals who want to defund the police, implement the Green New Deal, impose massive tax increases, and enact more socialist policies that would take freedom away from the American people.

Here's topline information about what the framework would mean for the American people, and who is responsible for developing it:

Health Care:

- While there's no direct endorsement of a one-size-fits-all government takeover of health care with a single-payer system, even though that policy is supported by [more than half of the House Democratic Caucus](#), the framework would lead to higher costs and fewer choices for patients by establishing government-run health care.
- Government-run health care, as this framework calls for, would be a disaster for America. It would begin the process of the total elimination of private health insurance, and put Washington, DC at the center of a relationship between doctors and patients.
- While this framework doesn't explicitly call for the establishment of a single-payer system, some of the individuals tasked with drafting it are some of the most vocal champions of an approach that's run completely and solely by the federal government. That includes Pramila Jayapal, who is the [chief sponsor](#) of the single-payer bill in the House, Don Berwick, who has a [lengthy track record of praising](#) socialized medicine, and Abdul El-Sayed who put [a single-payer plan](#) at the center of his failed campaign for Governor of Michigan.

Economy:

- The framework calls for the adoption of a \$15 minimum wage which would [eliminate as many as 4 million of jobs](#) from workers that need them the most. It [lifts language word-for-word](#) from Bernie Sanders previous platform when it comes to handouts to Big Labor, including the repeal of “Right-To-Work” laws, and not incentivizing the creation of unions. It also would call for the passage of legislation that would lead to reparations being paid by the government to Black Americans.
- While the country is experiencing historic deficits because of the unprecedented response needed to combat the coronavirus, the framework calls for massive new government spending in housing, infrastructure, and social security, and specifically states that taxes will be increased on higher-income Americans.
- The drafters of this framework have been proponents of fringe ideas like [the modern-monetary theory](#) which calls for printing an endless stream of money without concern for the nation’s debt and deficit, [establishing government-run “baby bonds,”](#) which would serve as a new government entitlement program for every American, [endorsing](#) the redistribution of wealth and [adopting](#) the Green New Deal.

Immigration:

- The outlines in this framework would weaken the positive developments that have been made to secure the border, specifically ending the policy that requires migrants to remain south of the border while their hearings are processed and other strategies implemented by this White House.
- It also calls for reform to the immigration system that provides amnesty to those who came to the country illegally, while imposing a 100 day moratorium on deportations, and “a full-scale study on current practices to develop recommendations for transforming enforcement policies and practices,” at ICE and Customs and Border Protection (CBP).”
- Even though it does not explicitly call for the abolishment of ICE or DHS, a number of individuals on the task force, [including the Director of Mijente](#), have made those demands in the past. In fact, [Mijente released a statement](#) after to task force document was finalized to indicate that they will continue pushing to abolish ICE, end the detention of all illegal immigrants who unlawfully attempt to enter the United States, and defund the police.

Energy:

- Calls for the elimination of coal, oil, and natural gas by 2035, and having net-zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050 at the latest, which would destroy millions of American jobs across the country in these critical sectors. They also want to achieve this by not tapping nuclear energy as a resource, and by eliminating carbon pollution from power plants in the next 15 years.
- The framework also says that a potential Biden Administration would pursue upwards of \$7 trillion in new spending on energy projects, and would pay for them by adding to the growing deficit or raising taxes on the American people. This new spending would go towards advancing electric vehicles, retrofitting buildings, and advancing the far-left’s climate and environmental justice goals.
- Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez, the brainchild of the Green New Deal which called for guaranteed income for every American, abolishing all fossil fuels within 10 years, and a complete upheaval

of America's entire economic system, signed off on the Biden plan. Though the plan did not reference the Green New Deal, it's clear a Biden presidency would follow this approach, destroying countless American jobs and moving to socialize our economy in the process.

Education:

- The Biden-Sanders framework that Biden is promising to follow if he's elected would devastate parents and students for the sole purpose of propping up Democrats' allies in the Teacher's Union. It would severely limit the creation of private schools that offer better educational opportunities for students, and end the practice of allowing students to use vouchers in order to receive a high-quality education.
- It also continues the commitment to endless spending by forcing taxpayers to provide college grants and free college, while putting the federal government at the center of students' learning experience from before kindergarten until after they graduate.
- Members of this task force have a track record of [attacking](#) school choice and doing everything in their power to prioritize the needs of the Teacher's Union before what's best for students to learn and create better opportunities. That would be the hallmark of education policy in a Biden Administration.

Criminal Justice:

- While the framework stops short of calling for the defunding of the police, even though Vice President Biden [suggested himself](#) that he supports those calls, it does promote investments in "community policing," and providing federal funding to create a "civilian corps" of unarmed first responders.
- The approach also suggests reducing the number of Americans who are imprisoned, regardless of the crime they commit, and releasing current inmates from custody. The framework makes no recognition of the brave sacrifices and heroic actions that members of law enforcement make on a daily basis to protect our society. It also does not denounce the lawless behavior of violent mobs who have torn down statues and attacked American history.
- In addition to defunding the police and weakening our criminal justice system, one member of this task force, Chiraag Bains, has been [active](#) in trying to change election law by "enacting automatic voter registration, same day registration, early voting, pre-registration for 16- and 17-year-olds, independent redistricting commissions, and rights restoration to people with convictions." He's called for ending felony disenfranchisement, granting statehood to D.C., and extending voting rights to territories.

It's no surprise that the socialists and the far-left have embraced this framework because it represents their takeover the Democrat Party. Joe Biden has abandoned any pretense of moderation or common sensibility to support these policies that represent a fundamental threat to the free enterprise, capitalist, and opportunity society that has defined America for more than two centuries.

It's clear that as President, he would not prioritize safeguarding freedom, and instead would cast it aside in favor of their extreme policies that would give more power and more control to the federal government. That is why the stakes in this election could not be higher; not only would a Biden presidency lead to disastrous policies for the American people, but it could spell the abandonment of the values we hold dear.
