

# Seeking Providers to Participate in Vaccine Community Conversations

Immunize Colorado is looking for pediatric healthcare providers who would be interested in offering patients extra opportunities to receive vaccine education by participating in small-group community conversations about immunizations.

## For Who?

To help increase vaccine education and reduce uncertainties surrounding vaccines, Immunize Colorado will be hosting a series of community conversations for parents/guardians from the Latinx community where they will have the opportunity to ask any questions surrounding immunizations in a jargon-free setting.

## When?

April, May, or June. Ideally, we are also looking for providers who would be available around lunch time or after hours on week nights in order to best accommodate the schedules of our target population. We are able to work with the provider to plan the sessions based on their availability.

## Where?

The community conversations will be split between Zoom and in-person. We can work with you to determine a location that best fits your needs and the needs of attendees.

## What is provided?

Immunize Colorado will provide marketing support by designing flyers and other promotional materials and will help with outreach and marketing to the Latinx community. We will also provide tech support by setting up and moderating the Zoom sessions. A stipend will also be provided for the provider as well as food during the in-person sessions.

## What else are we looking for?

We are looking for enthusiastic providers who are eager to share continued immunization knowledge with the Latinx community. Spanish-speaking providers are desired but not required. Immunize Colorado can provide translator services.
