i-Tree an Urban Forestry software suite offering a variety of detailed UF management tools. i-Tree Eco is an environmental services benefits model designed to quantify the structure, environmental effects, and value of trees in urban and wildland-urban ecosystems. The results from an i-Tree Eco project can be used by natural resource managers, municipal planners and community groups to make effective resource management decisions, to develop policies, and set priorities.
