

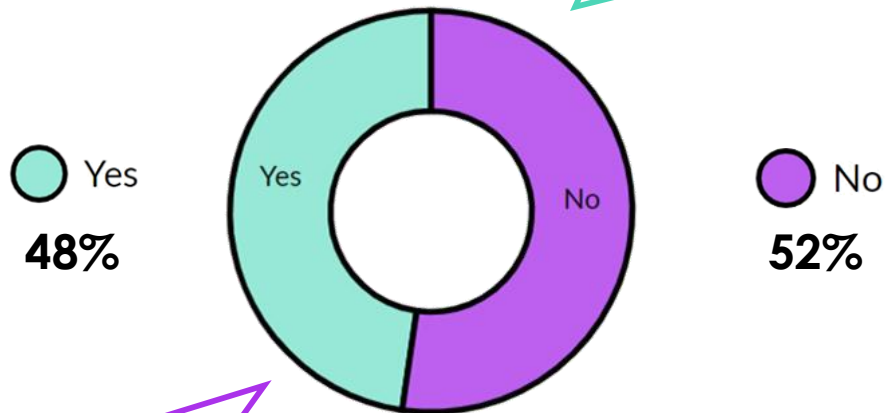


Vote Results:
