



# MARION ST DRILLED SHAFT WORK BEGINS AS EARLY AS APRIL 26

Marion St between Alaskan Way and Western Ave will have significant traffic restrictions starting as early as April 26, including a 4-week closure to all vehicles, to install foundations for the future Marion Street Bridge. This work may also cause noise and vibration in the area. Early foundation work is expected to be complete in late June.

The City of Seattle and the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) will rebuild the Marion Street Bridge from Western Ave to Colman Dock starting as early as fall 2021.

## WORK ZONE:

- Marion St between Western Ave and Alaskan Way

## SCHEDULE AND HOURS:

- Monday-Friday, 7AM to 5PM
- Occasional overnight and weekend work

## PEDESTRIAN AND VEHICLE ACCESS:

- Marion St closed to vehicle access 24/7 for about 4 weeks
- Lane closures on south side of Marion St before and after the full closure
- Pedestrian access maintained on the north side only
- Access to businesses will be maintained

## EQUIPMENT AND NOISE:

- Work includes large equipment (drill rigs and cranes) and drilling, may cause some noise and vibration
- Construction equipment and vehicles moving in and out of the work zone
- Construction trucks and equipment may be noisy

## PARKING AND LOAD ZONES:

- No parking on Marion St for the duration of the work
- Temporary parking restrictions on Western Ave between Marion and Columbia streets
