



## GEOLOGICA BELGICA MEETING SECOND ANNOUNCEMENT

### THE REVISED STRATIGRAPHY OF THE EIFELIAN

One day field trip on Friday 27th of March 2020

Guide: Julien Denayer (ULiège)

Programme :

**Meeting point** at 9:00 in Petigny near Couvin  
(parking in rue des Fontaines)



1. Outcrops in Petigny exposing the lower part of the Couvin Formation, including the newly introduced Petigny Member (dark fine-grained facies) and Cul d'Efer Member (coral-stromatoporoid biostromes).
2. Outcrop in La Roche Trouée in Nismes exposing a small bioherm and its overlying facies in the upper part of the Couvin Formation.

Lunchtime

3. Road section in Vierves-sur-Viroin exposing the newly introduced Vierves Member (argillaceous lateral equivalent of the Couvin Formation) and its contact with underlying Vieux Moulin Member and overlying Chavées Member.
4. (Optional) Shaly and silty Vieux Moulin Member in Treignes.
5. Outcrops in Wancennes near Beauraing and/or in Pondrôme (depending on weather conditions) exposing the very large reef of the Wancennes Member.

End of the trip around 5:30.

Note: number of cars restricted to 5 or 6 for parking limitation (25-30 participants maximum).

Lunch will be taken in a café in Olloy-sur-Viroin but participants will bring their own lunch.
