



CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE ESSENTIAL EMPLOYEE AUTHORIZATION TO TRAVEL

To Whom It May Concern:

The person in possession of this letter is a contractor for TechLink Services and performs vital work in the Communications, Information Technology and Food and Agricultural Sectors. These areas have been deemed essential and critical to the infrastructure in the United States.

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security identified 16 critical industries essential to the infrastructure of the United States. These sectors' assets, systems, and networks, whether physical or virtual, are considered so vital to the United States that their incapacitation or destruction would have a debilitating effect on security, national economic security, national public health or safety, or any combination thereof. Presidential Policy Directive 21 (PPD-21). According to these guidelines, employees of companies engaged in work in these industries should be allowed free travel for work purposes. The Communications Sector has been deemed essential as it provides an enabling function across all critical infrastructures. This contractor will help deliver critical communications tools to other critical sectors such as the health industry, energy industry, restaurant industry and government facilities.

The Information Technology Sector is central to the nation's security, economy, and public health and safety as businesses, governments, academia, and private citizens are increasingly dependent upon Information Technology Sector functions. This employee will help produce and provide hardware, software, and information technology systems and services, and—in collaboration with the Communications Sector—the Internet.

The Food and Agricultural (FA) Sector is composed of complex production, processing, and delivery systems and has the capacity to feed people and animals both within and beyond the boundaries of the United States. Beyond domestic food production, the FA Sector also imports many ingredients and finished products, leading to a complex web of growers, processors, suppliers, transporters, distributors, and consumers. This sector is critical to maintaining and securing our food supply

The contractor in possession of this letter must be allowed to travel, regardless of time of day, in order to properly carry out their work functions. This travel and this employees' job function will assist in keeping the critical infrastructures described above functioning in this time of crisis.
