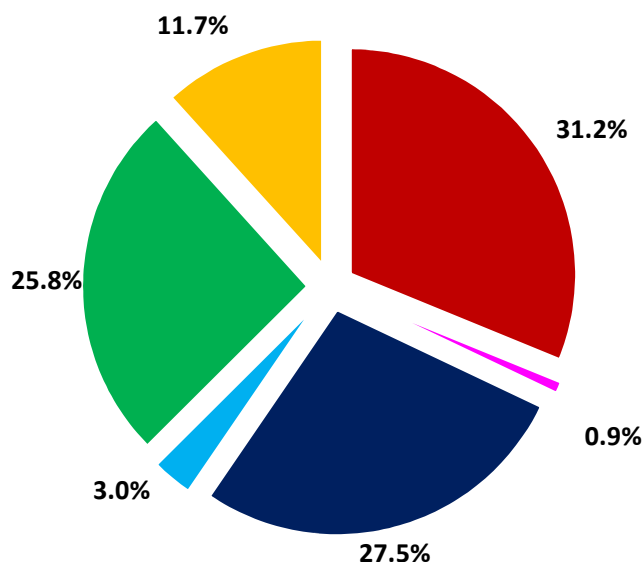

### 2020 General Election Early Voting Analysis October 21, 2020

This report is based on data provided by the Texas Secretary of State and the county clerks from all 254 counties. Reference to previous election history are based on the elections an individual has participated in over the last four election cycles.

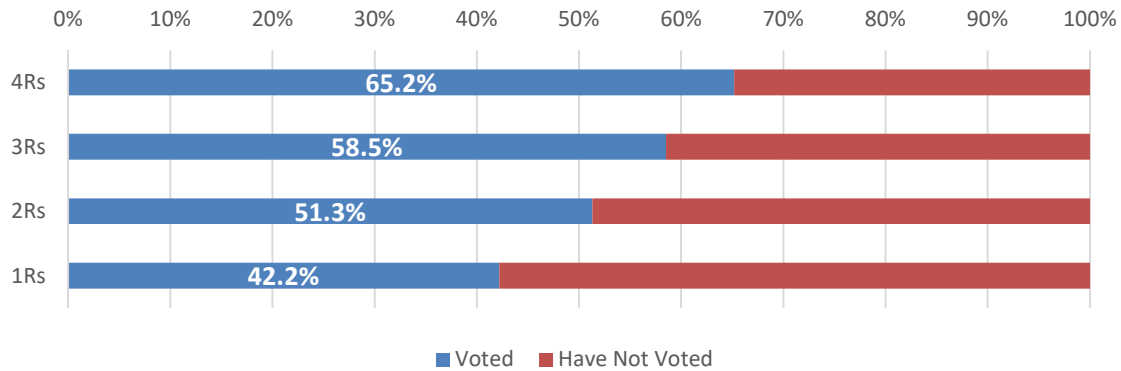

## Are Republicans Showing Up to Vote?

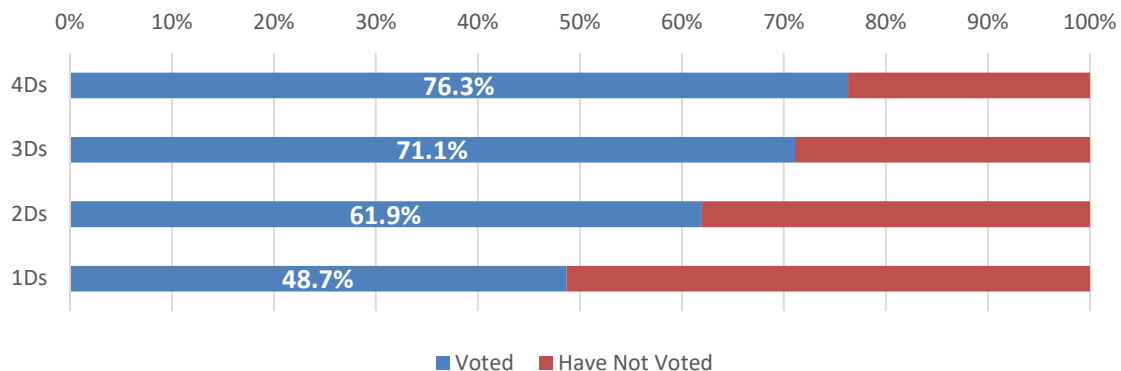
The following is a breakdown of voters with previous Republican Primary election history and whether they have voted early or not.



Category	<u>Voted Early</u>
4Rs - Voters who have voted in 4 of the previous 4 Republican Primaries.	65.2%
3Rs - Voters who have voted in exactly 3 of the previous 4 Republican Primaries	58.5%
2Rs - Voters who have voted in exactly 2 of the previous 4 Republican Primaries	51.3%
1Rs - Voters who have voted in exactly 1 of the previous 4 Republican Primaries	42.2%

## Are Democrats Showing Up to Vote?

The following is a breakdown of voters with previous Democratic Primary election history and whether they have voted early or not.

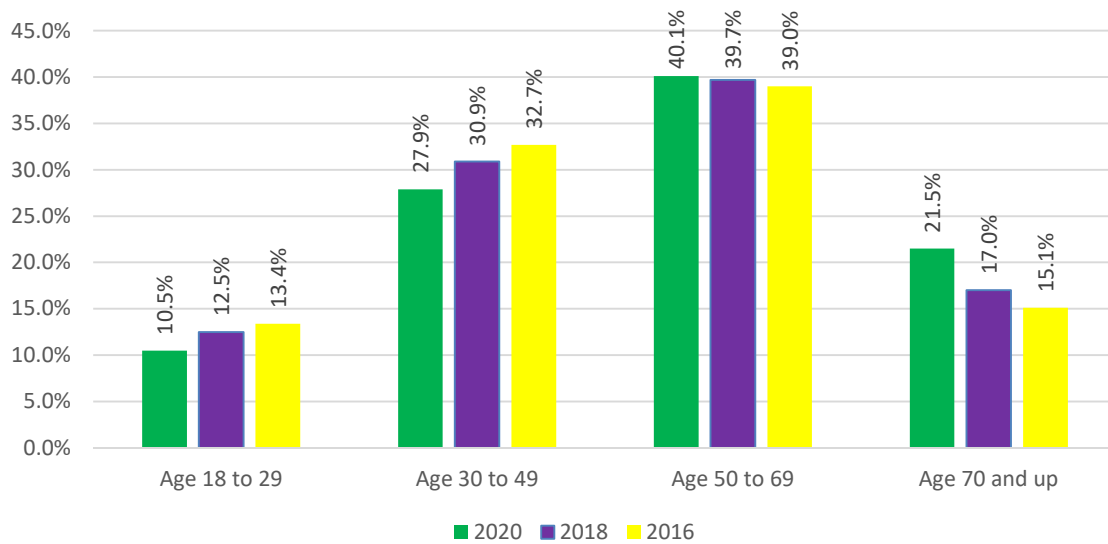


Category	<u>Voted Early</u>
4Ds - Voters who have voted in 4 of the previous 4 Democratic Primaries	76.3%
3Ds - Voters who have voted in exactly 3 of the previous 4 Democratic Primaries	71.1%
2Ds - Voters who have voted in exactly 2 of the previous 4 Democratic Primaries	61.9%
1Ds - Voters who have voted in exactly 1 of the previous 4 Democratic Primaries	48.7%

# Early Voter Demographics

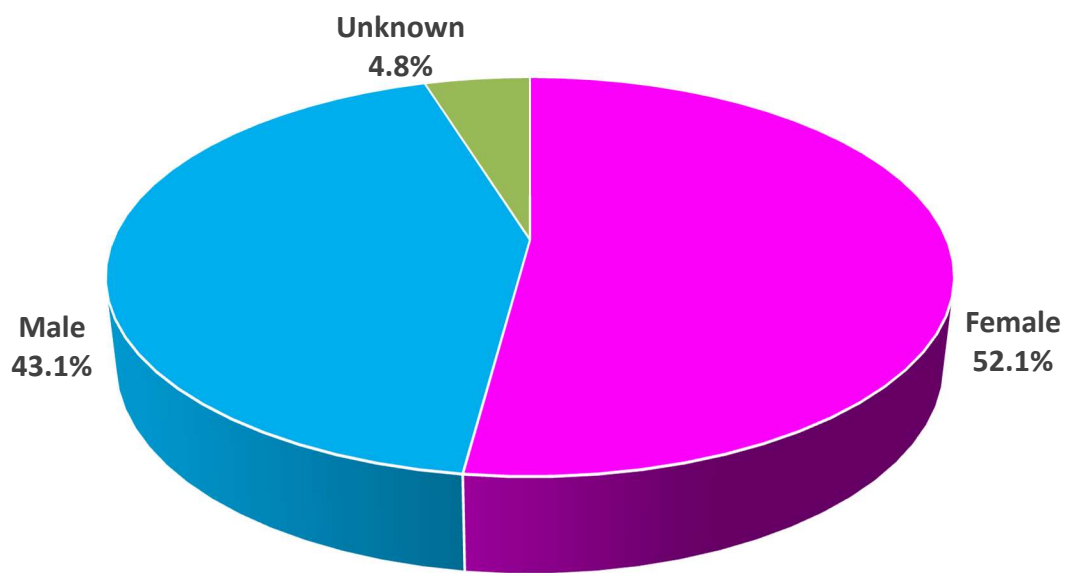
## By Age

## By Gender

This chart shows the percentage by gender of voters who have voted early. Some records on the Texas Secretary of State's voter file do not include a gender. These individuals are classified as "Unknown."



## Early Voters by Previous Election History Largest Counties Only

This is a breakdown of each group's share of all votes cast during early voting. Republican Primary voters with no previous Democratic Primary election history make up 23.0% of all votes cast in Harris County.
