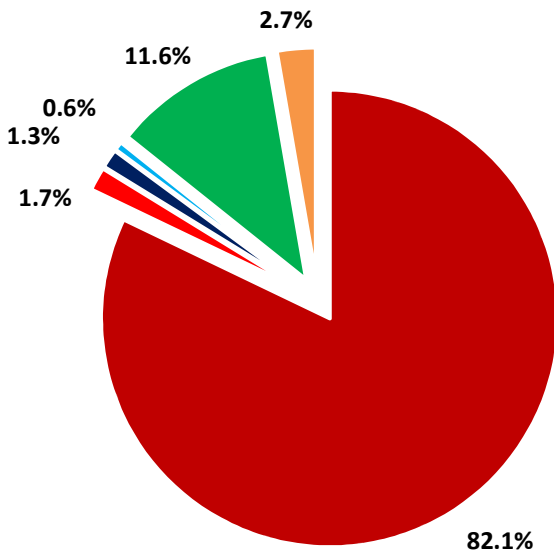

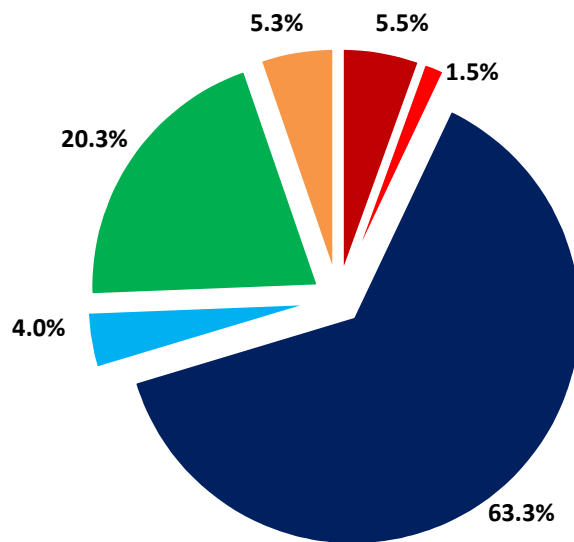
The following information is based on data collected from the Texas Secretary of State and county elections administrators across the state.

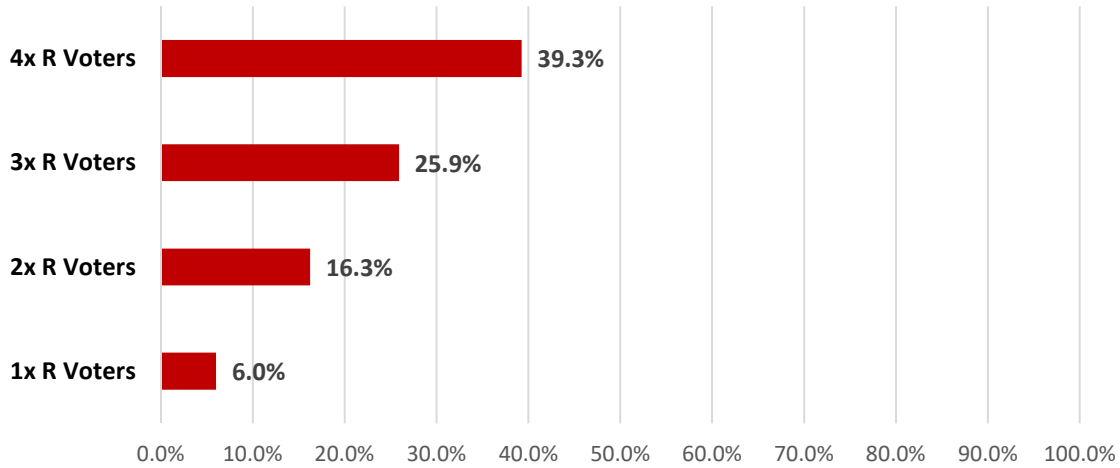

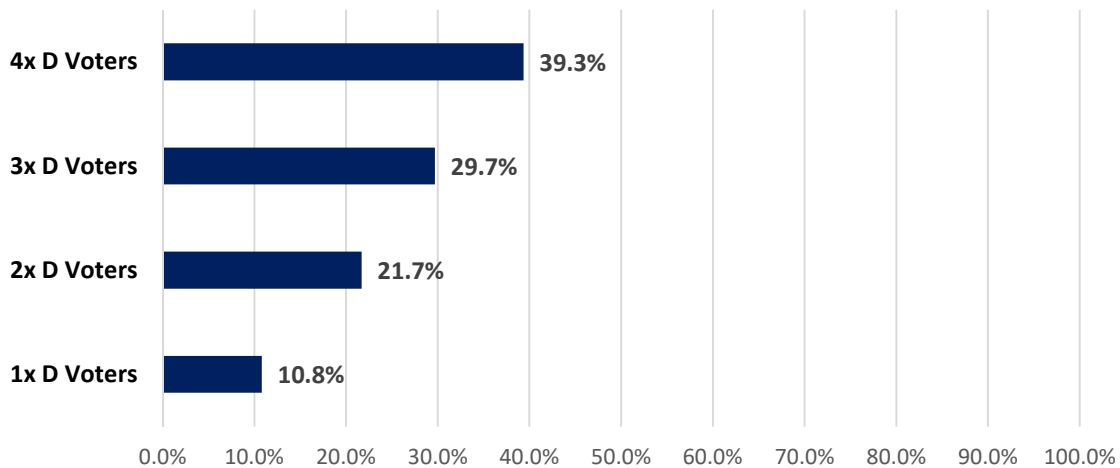
Are Republicans Showing Up to Vote in the Republican Primary?

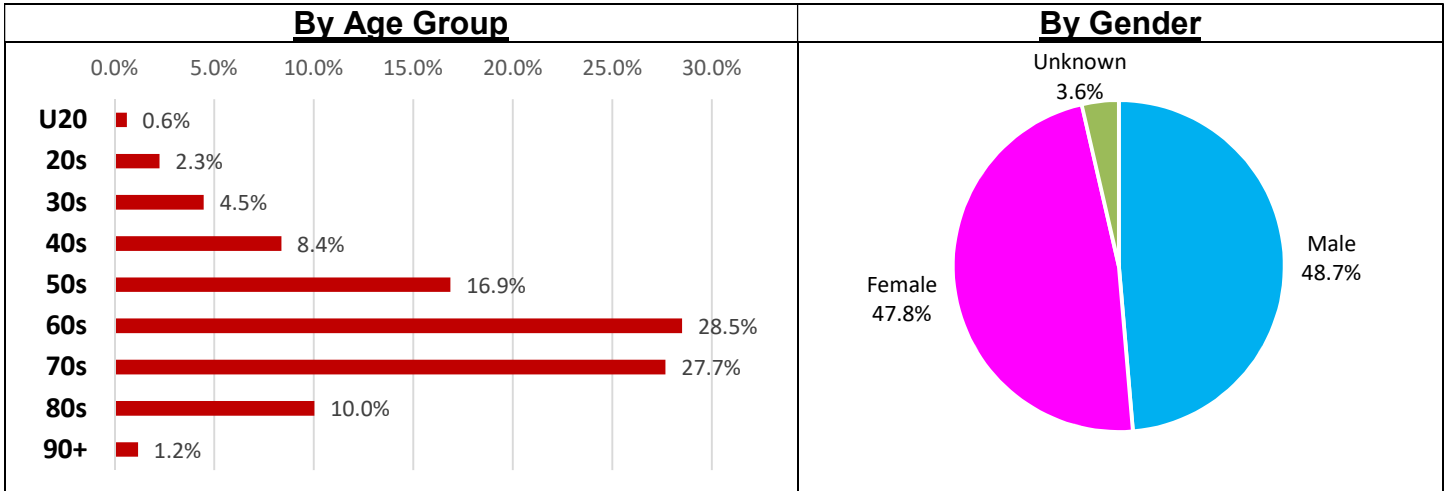
Are Democrats Showing Up to Vote in the Democratic Primary?

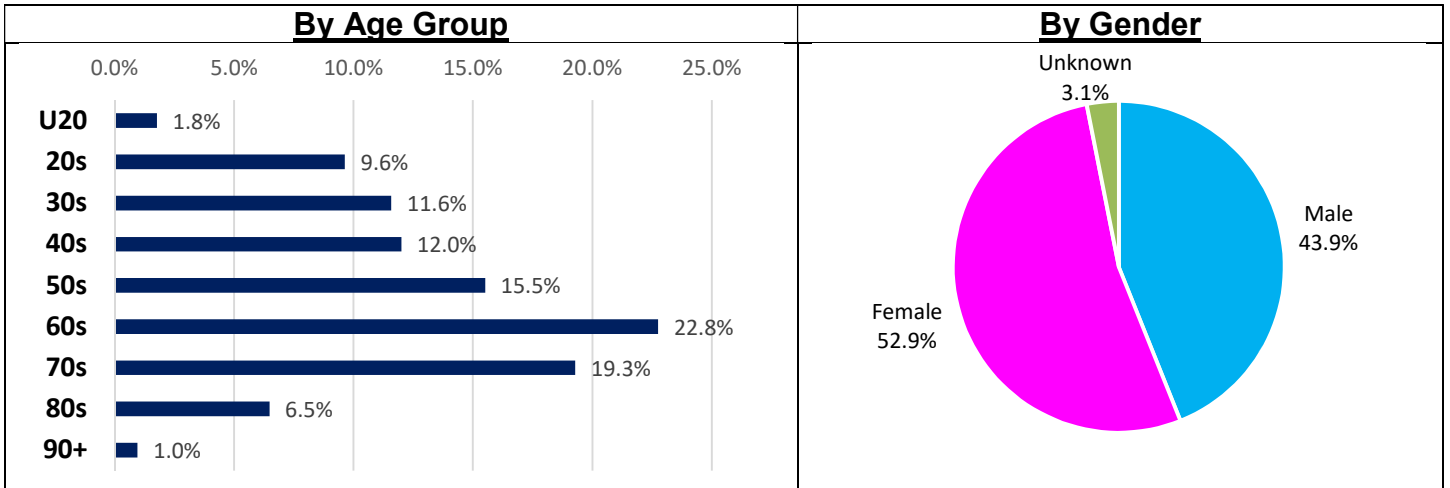


Early Voters by Demographics
